## Estimating & ordering updates

### QUOTING

### **Allow excluding stock price from markups and adjustments**

We have added more granular control around inventory-based stock pricing. You will now be able to exclude your stock price from different types of adjustments, so you can separate out your stock margins from your overheads and profit margins.

### **MATERIALS - Charge based on order pricing**

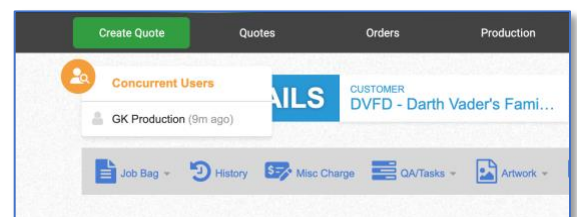
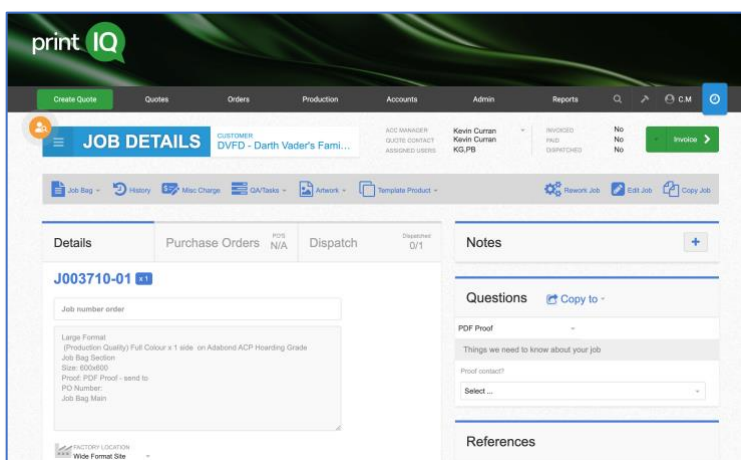
Against a material, we have added the option to link the 'Order Units' to auto calculate the 'Charge Unit'. This is useful in situations where a material is ordered as a roll of 100 meters at \$100 per roll and the charge is per meter and the charge unit set to \$1. Any price updated to the 'Order Units' will then also pass on to the 'Charge Unit'. When the 'Order Units' are updated to \$110 per roll the charge will then increase to \$1.10 per meter.

### Implement Runs Calculator in GetPrice API

We've added the RunsCalculatorInput to the ProductionOptions section of the GetPrice API. When provided, the API will now create a job that uses the runs calculator to automatically determine the required number of runs for your kinds. This enhancement streamlines setup and ensures more accurate production planning.

### Sales Order Status Update API

You are now able to keep the status of your sales orders in sync between printIQ and your external system automatically, using a new endpoint specifically for changing the status of a sales order. This will perform all the same functions as changing it within the application, such as picking and returning stock.
